In this role, you will gain hands-on experience across a wide range of digital technology including broadcast media systems, video servers and processing systems, IP network technology and corporate IT systems.


In addition to gaining hands-on experience in a varied technical role, you will also complete a *Diploma in Digital Technology – IT Infrastructure SCQF level 6*.
